## From The Editor

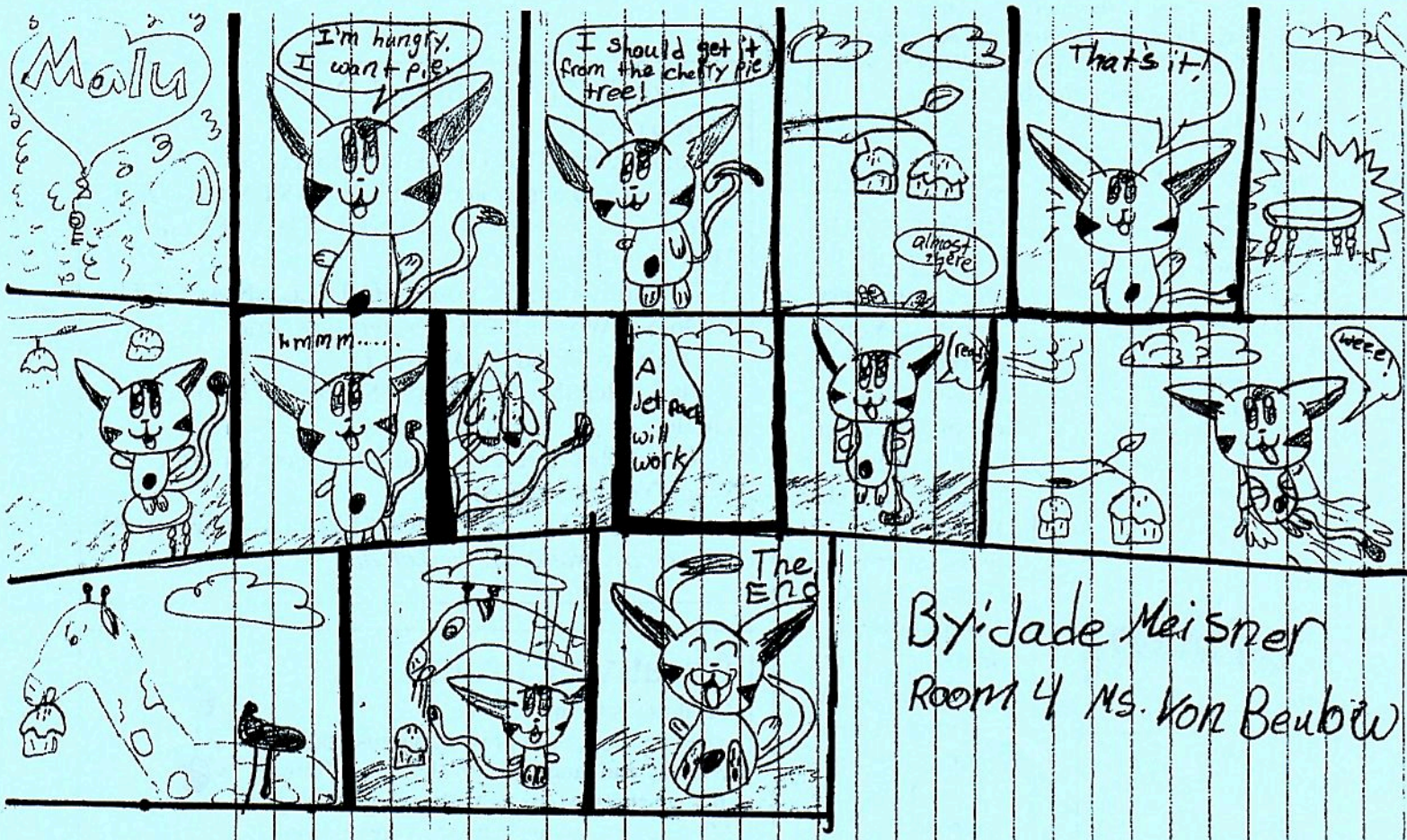
Dear Readers,
